Palliative Bed

A palliative care bed is specifically designed to provide comfort and support for individuals with advanced illnesses. These beds often have features that make them suitable for people with limited mobility or specific medical needs.

- Adjustable height: This allows for easier patient care and transfers.
- Head and foot elevation: Providing comfort and reducing pressure points.
- Side rails: Enhancing safety and preventing falls.
- Special mattresses: Designed to prevent pressure sores and provide optimal comfort.

Essentially, a palliative care bed is adapted to meet the unique needs of people receiving palliative care, ensuring their comfort and dignity.

IndeeLift Hoist

An IndeeLift Hoist is a specialized lifting device designed to safely and easily lift a person from the floor to a standing or seated position.

It's often referred to as a "human floor lift" or "people picker upper."

This type of equipment is particularly beneficial for:

- Elderly individuals: Helping them regain independence after a fall.
- People with disabilities: Providing a safe and efficient way to transfer.
- Caregivers: Reducing the risk of injury from manual lifting.

IndeeLift hoists are typically portable and easy to use making them suitable for both home.

Shower Chair

A shower chair is a safety device designed to help individuals with mobility issues bathe safely and independently.

It provides a stable seating option within the shower, reducing the risk of falls and injuries.

Benefits of using a shower chair:
